Y4-6 Skiing Club and Activity

During the Michaelmas term, children in Years 4, 5 and 6 and Lent term, children in Years 4 and 5 are given the opportunity to take part in a Friday afternoon skiing activity and club once more. (Year 6 will be busy rehearsing for their play in the Lent term).

We are planning to run three courses simultaneously. The first one is aimed at children who are already able to ski and are skiing at an intermediate level. This means that they are able to use a button lift and ski using a snowplough. They should also be able to stop safely. The club is aimed at improving their skills. The children will be taught by a trained instructor. It is also possible to accommodate more advanced skiers. The second is for those wanting to develop and improve racing skills, using gates etc. and can be combined with course 2.

The third course is for absolute beginners.

The clubs will run on a Friday afternoon, starting in the 'Activities' lesson and will finish after school for children to be picked up at Suffolk Leisure Park (Suffolk Ski Centre, Bourne Hill, Ipswich) at 4.30 pm or back at school at 5.00 pm. We will take the children to Suffolk Leisure Park in a minibus.

At this stage the children do not need specialist equipment but will need gloves, long sleeves and trousers. We will be skiing if it rains, so they also need waterproof tops and bottoms should rain be forecast. The children will also need their water bottle.

The course of ten lessons will run from Friday 16th September – Friday 2nd December 2016 inclusive. The cost of the course will be £72.00 per pupil which covers all travel, hire of ski equipment and instruction.

We have also just taking possession of our new ski equipment, kindly donated by the FRIENDS of Ipswich School. If your child is an advanced skier, there may be the opportunity to use this new equipment (more details to follow if your child signs up).

Places for the courses are very limited and if we are over-subscribed, current ski club members who wish to continue will be offered places first along with those who have signed up to the ski trip to Italy, thereafter, we will draw names from a hat.
