#### Eddy Alcock (OI 1949-1954) Receives OBE

Recent former President of the OI Club, Eddy Alcock was awarded an OBE earlier in the month. From an article in the EADT:

"Eddy Alcock, 76, from Debenham, has received an OBE for public and voluntary service.

The former Suffolk County Council chairman has worked for decades supporting community groups including the village's youth club and the Rotary Club of High Suffolk. He said: "I don't believe that anybody who chooses to give any sort of service to the community has any expectation of receiving any form of recognition. I feel greatly honored therefore to be a recipient of this award and very grateful to those who have considered me to be worthy of it."

He was a retained firefighter for 10 years, becoming president of the Retained Firefighters' Union in 1981.

Helping at Debenham's leisure center he contributed to raising £1.25million for new and improvements to facilities."
